Lilli is shocked when she finds out that her new friend is in need as well: Since he has lost his pack Askan is living in a state of eternal migration. Everywhere he goes he is chased away and threatened. Lilli wants to help him but she has not much time left ... Successful author Tanya Stewner shows very sensitively how a deep friendship between wolf and girl comes alive.

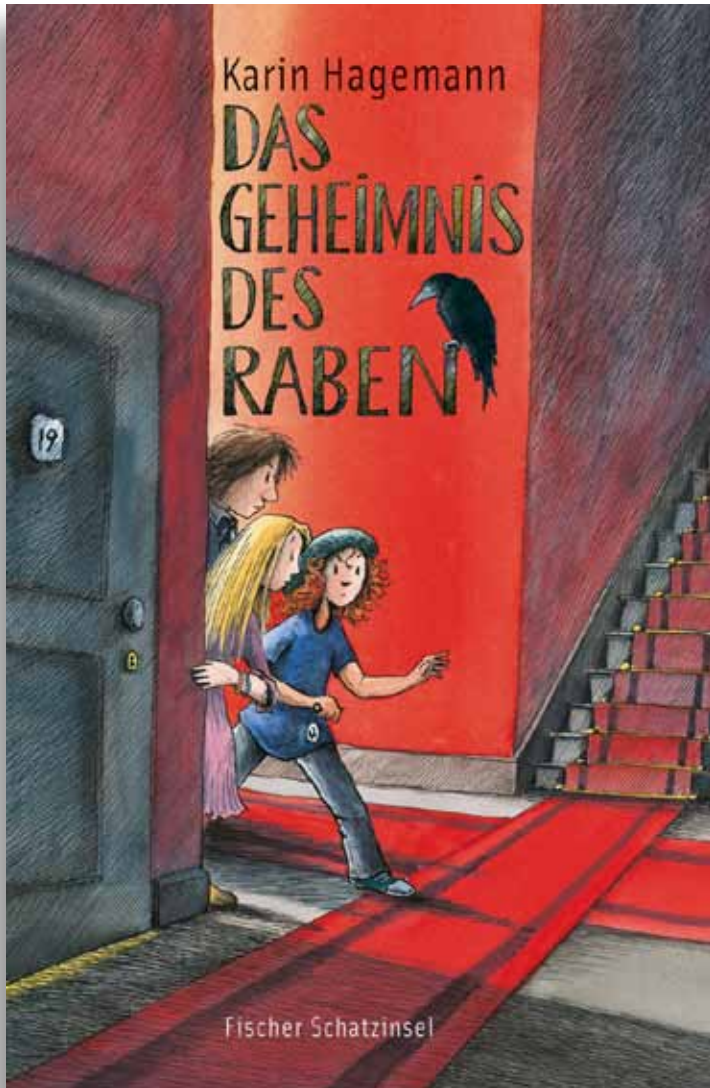

While looking for hints about her mother Fritzi finds out that in the museum forged paintings are exhibited. Who are the art forgers? And what has her mother got to do with all that?

Karin Hagemann presents with this book a fascinating art thriller for children – a joint project with the Städel Art Museum in Frankfurt.

Together with his new friends Linus and Frederike Orbi even succeeds in putting a stop to the activities of a nasty gang of crooks!

Disappointed Ella retires to the vault – where she meets (at last!) a young vampire: Konrad. Konrad does look a bit strange for he has freckles. When one evening her mother does not come home from work and Lila is taken to a remote farm by her alleged aunt Bella Lila realizes that her mother never really told her the truth. Therefore Lila starts looking for [answers: Where did her mother go? Why are so many children whisked off to children's homes and – damn it – who is that guy who constantly shows up? Lila gets into the middle of Fireland the slums outside the city and finds shelter with a gang of kids.

Susanne Fischer tells of a society that is in danger of forgetting its social responsibility, of strong children, ignorant adults and of the courage to change things.

**Susanne Fischer**, born 1960 in Hamburg, is an author, publisher and literary scholar and has worked as journalist and editor for audioplays. 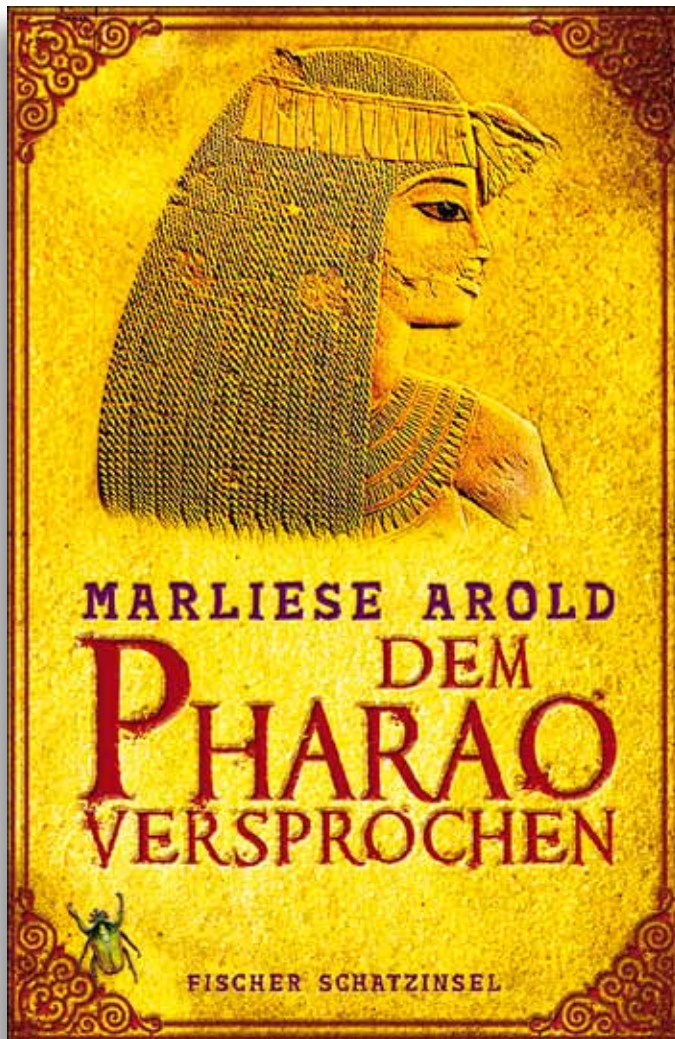

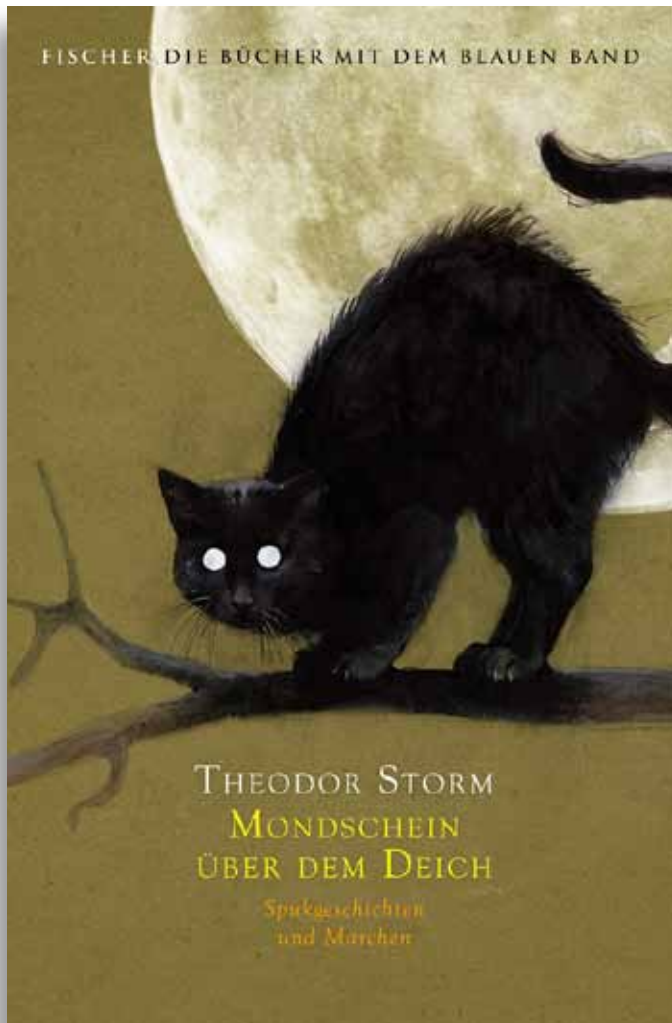
For her Egyptian novel Marliese Arold did a long and thorough research. She has Tutenchamun and all the facets and details of his times come to life.

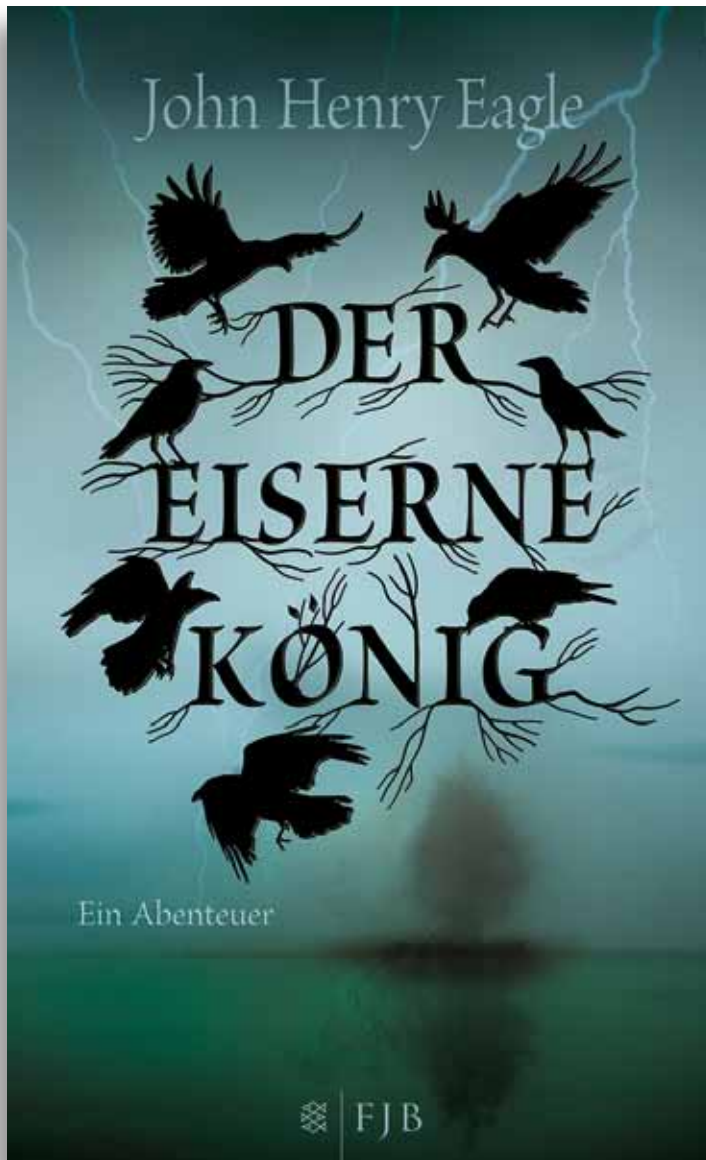

The world is carried by an ash tree, cared for by five fairies. The Karontides, though, monsters of the underworld since the beginning of time do everything to make this ash tree dry up. Should they succeed our world will perish and the iron king will rise again and establish his rule of terror. This has to be stopped – with the help of a wondrous girl, who has green eyes, hair the colour of honey, freckles and the picture of a labyrinth on her back, a map. Two groups of figures are in pursuit of this messenger, one group to save the world, the other to destroy it. Hans and Sneewitt get on their way, with active support of other heroes they will have to master fights and adventures, but so does Grimm, the robber and soldier of the iron king, who is supported by the seven demonic ravens. A third team is made up of fox and badger, two representatives of the animal world, who support Sneewitt and her companions in a shrewd and cunning way.

**John Henry Eagle** was born in 1971 as the son of a British officer based at the Luneburg Heath and a German mother. After an erratic school career which had him attend several boarding schools he worked his way up to be a stockbroker in London but then backed out and returned to Germany to devote himself to writing. Under a pseudonym he wrote filmscripts, gothic novels and scenarios for graphic novels. »Der Eiserne König« (The Iron King) is the first book to be published under his real name. He lives with many cats in the vicinity of Berlin.
